### Road Closures Sunday 19th May 2024, 5:15AM to 11:00AM

- West Bound Lanes of Hornibrook Esplanade from Oxley Ave to Ted Smout Bridge from 5.15am-10.30am.
- Southbound bridge traffic will be diverted onto Houghton Highway Bridge which will be in operation at this time with contra flow and variable speed conditions.
- Two-way directional traffic will be managed in the north bound lanes on Houghton Highway Bridge with variable speed conditions.
- Drivers may still enter Hornibrook Esplanade from Houghton Highway and continue eastbound to Oxley Avenue.

### Please use Elizabeth Ave to access southbound on Houghton Highway Bridge.

Please note that there will be no vehicle access to Pelican Park from the Maine Rd intersection or from the Thomas Street intersection and the public boat ramp and associated car park will be closed from 5am until the road reopens at 11.00am.

Pelican Park will be closed for the event on Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> May 2024 until approx 1pm. Some internal roads will be closed to facilitate setup from Friday 17<sup>th</sup> May 2024.
